MESSAGE FROM - Ted Antonopoulos, *Golf Professional*

We are pleased to announce that Mayacama Golf Club was selected as a local qualifying site for the 108th United States Open Championship, which will be played June 12-15, 2008 at Torrey Pines in San Diego, California.

The Qualifying Tournament was held on Tuesday, May 13. Six players from the field of 90 players qualified for the second phase of the qualifying process - a Sectional Qualifying Tournament at Lake Merced Golf Club in San Francisco to be played on June 2, 2008.

Amateur Kory Storer from San Mateo was Medalist with a score of 69. Windsor's Jason Schmuhl secured the sixth and final spot with a birdie on the first play-off hole, while four other players continued the playoff to determine the two alternate spots.

The golf course, which was set up for the competition by Mayacama Golf Course Superintendent Dale Engman and Professional Ted Antonopoulos, received rave reviews from the players as well as the officials from the Northern California Golf Association, who administered the event for the USGA. The success of this event has helped lead us into further conversations with the USGA regarding the selection of Mayacama Golf Club as a future site for a USGA Championship.
